Then a woman born in Germany, living in the US, made a movie of hope called "On Our Own" to inspire young German Girls who have been abandoned to "Never Give Up"... and used that part of Alexis' creation to propel her movie internationally.

Alexis has dedicated her new Rocket, "Let It Go", to all of the women in the world searching for and living their dreams, and all the men that support them. A portion of the net proceeds from this vehicle will go to institutions, organizations, and foundations that spread Peace, Hope, and Love throughout the world using educational and creative endeavors.
